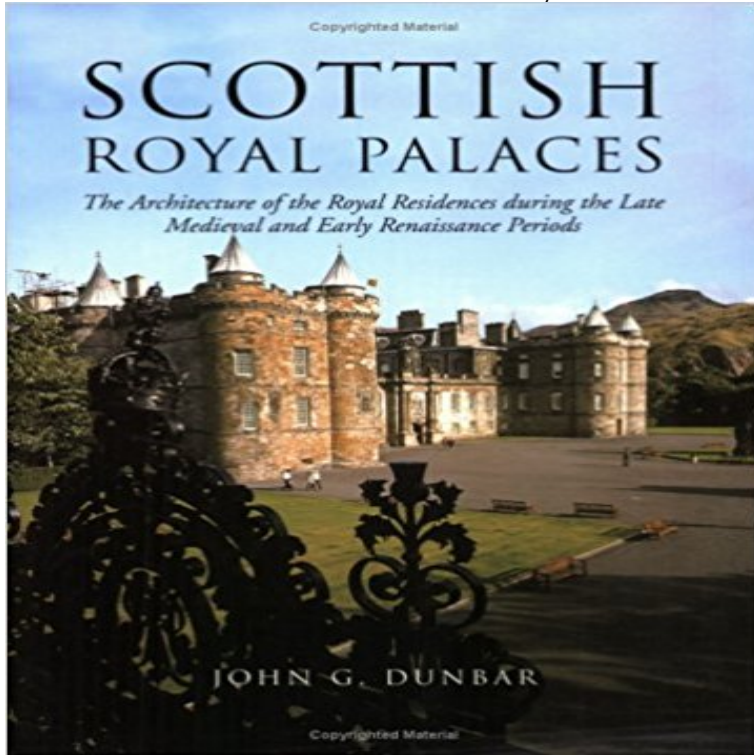


# Scottish Royal Palaces: The Architecture of the Royal Residences During the Late Medieval and Early Renaissance Periods

The author charts the growth of these buildings, the organization of the royal works, and the roles of the principal officials and tradesmen responsible for the construction and maintenance of the royal houses.
