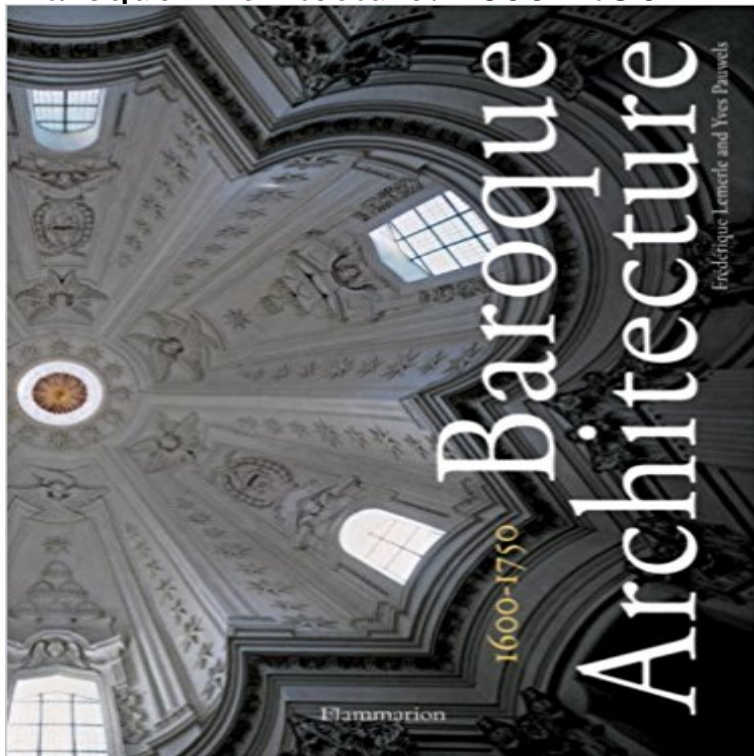


## Baroque Architecture: 1600-1750
