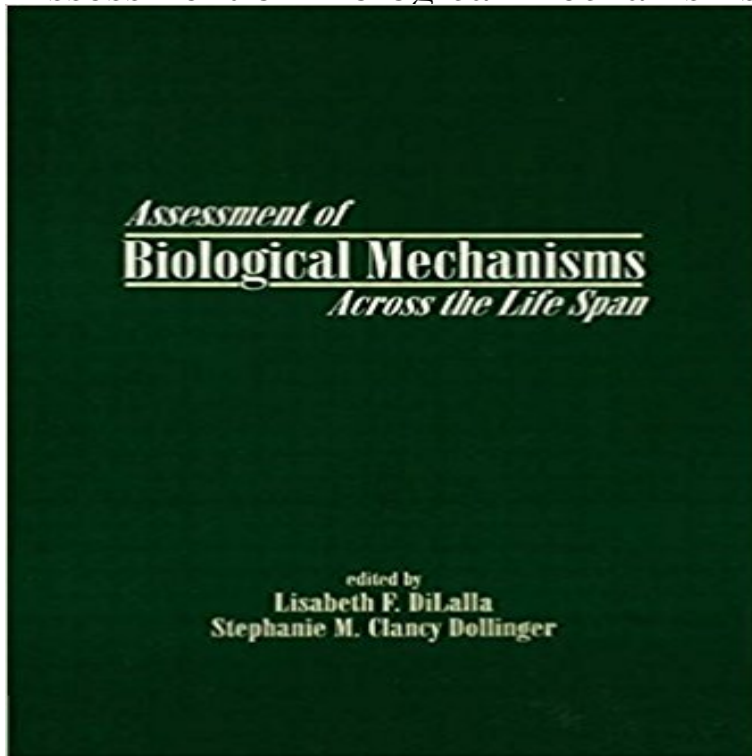


Assessment of Biological Mechanisms Across the Life Span
