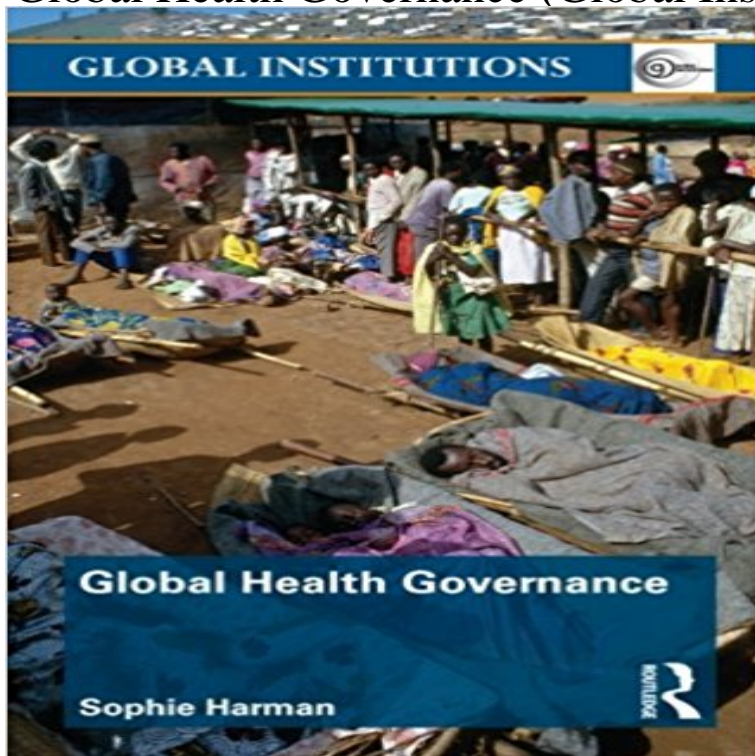


Global Health Governance (Global Institutions)
