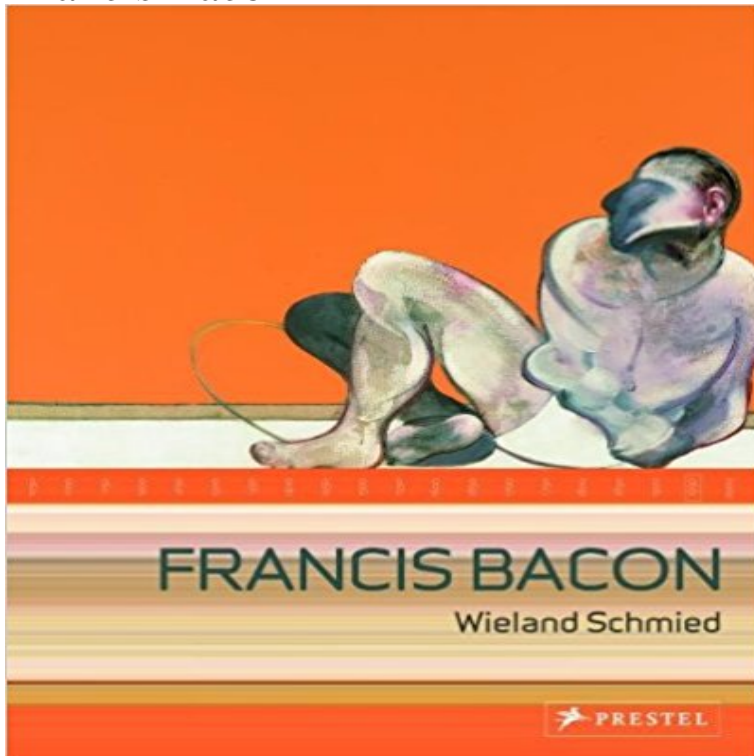


Francis Bacon
