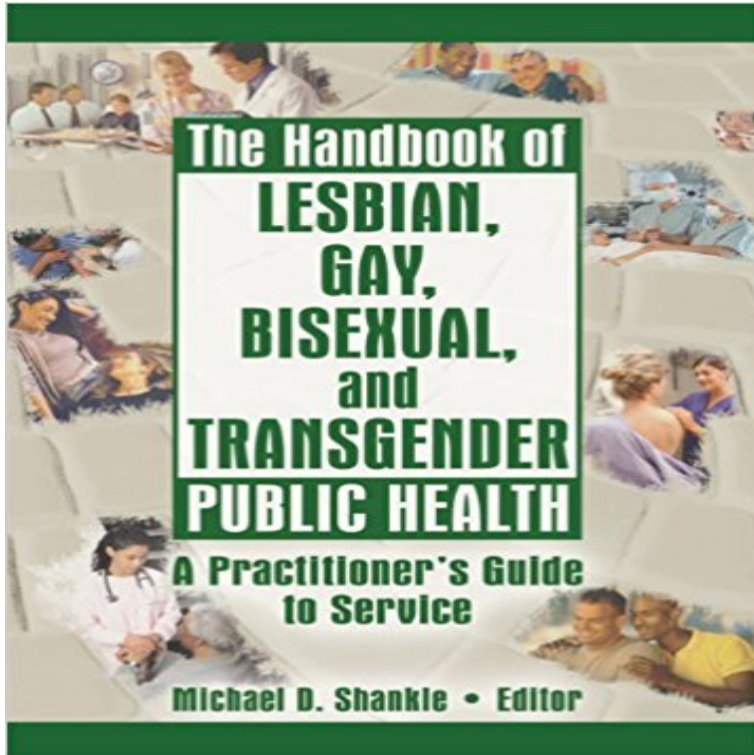


The Handbook of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender Public Health: A Practitioners Guide to Service
